



INVITATION TO TENDER

BINTAN ISLAND POWER PLANT TURNKEY EPC COAL FIRED POWER PLANT, JETTY including COAL UNLOADING and TRANSMISSION

Gallant Venture Limited (GVL) operates private power facilities for Bintan Resorts and Bintan Inti Industrial Estate (BIIE) on Bintan Island, Indonesia, 45 kilometres south east of Singapore. GVL is planning an expansion of their resort and industrial/ commercial facilities including a Lobam City development on Bintan Island. These activities will require additional electrical power supply in both the short and long term.

GVL is inviting companies that are suitably qualified and experienced to tender for the turnkey EPC delivery of the new power system requirements. The requirements include a 2 x 30 MW (net) coal fired power plant with the option of an additional third 30 MW (net) unit plus the necessary transmission (150 kV) to interconnect the new power plant with the existing Bintan Resorts and BIIE power plants and also a jetty and coal unloading system to receive barged coal and transfer it to the power plant stockpile. There are three separate turnkey EPC packages of work and interested parties may tender for any one or two or all three packages of work. The packages of work are:

PACKAGE 1

Power Plant - 2 x 30 MW (net) coal fired power plant with option of third identical unit.

PACKAGE 2

Transmission - 150 kV transmission and interconnection from new power plant to existing power plants including SCADA and load shedding systems.

PACKAGE 3

Jetty Facilities – Jetty and coal unloading system and infrastructure to receive coal delivered by barge.
